

Recruiting exceptional candidates is even more crucial in today's ever changing economy. Nigerian- Americans have more post graduate degrees than any other racial or ethnic groups. Albeit, they represent minutia portion of U.S. population, 54 percent of them hold bachelor's degrees and 30 percent a master's. 29 percent of Nigerian- Americans over the age of 25 hold a graduate degree, compared to 11% of

the overall U.S. population according to the Migrations Policy Institute. Nigerian-Americans create jobs, treat patients, teach students and contribute to local communities all while confidently emerging as one of the country's most successful immigrant communities; more likely to be counted in the higher income brackets at 35% of Nigerian- American households earn \$90,000 per year.

Nigerian accounts for less than 1 percent of the black population in the United States, yet, they make up nearly 25% of all Black students at Harvard Business School. Nigerian-Americans' achievements in the world of education top any other U.S. immigrant groups.




